Undoubtedly, they deserve the highest form of appreciation for the rare grit and determination they exhibited in accomplishing their coveted goals. The mental trauma and crippling constraints, imposed by the pandemic failed to fetter their spirits. They were undaunted, unwavering, and indomitable, very much like their mentors who lived up to the challenges thrown up by the new normal, by delivering education at the doorstep of students.

### **ACADEMICS**

- Among our glittering stars the most coveted place has been bagged by **Pulkit Aghi, the All-India class XII, CBSE topper of 2020 Board Exams, who placed our small town Karnal firmly on the top of the educational map of India. He secured a whopping 99.6% marks in XII Com. Board exam and set a new benchmark by scoring unbeaten 100 in Accountancy, Mathematics & Business Studies and 99 marks in English & Economics. He was invited by Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi to witness the Republic Day Celebrations 2020 in New Delhi.**
- He was followed by Nikunj, Disha and Khushi with 98%, while Saurabh and Ishika shared the third spot with 97% marks. At the secondary level, Raghav Gupta of class 10th with 96.8% was the school topper in the session 2019-20, while Keshav Bhardwaj with 96% secured the second position and Dhruv Gupta with 95.8% stood third.
- In the session 2019-20, 22 of our students scripted history by scoring cent percent marks in five major subjects and were awarded Merit Certificates by CBSE.
- Pratap's flag fluttered high even in the session 2020-21, despite the pandemic pummeling the education sector. Tanvi Chutani topped the district with 99.2% in XII Commerce. She was followed by Nitin who with 99% marks stood second and Manika bagged the third position with 98.4%. At Secondary Level, Ridhima with 98.4% stood first in the school. Pawni Sharma with 98% and Jahnvi Sharma with 97.2% were ranked second and third respectively.
- The young Pratapians continued their winning-spree in 2021-22 session as well. They swept the topmost positions in the district in both class 12 and 10 board exams.
- Vrinda Goyal stood first with 97.8%. whereas, Ansh Popli with 97% came second Samridhi scored 96.4% and stood third in school. At the secondary level Vidhi Chopra with 97.6% stood first. Lakshit Malhotra and Sanya both shared II position with 96.6% while Vani came third with 96.4% marks.
- Another remarkable feature of this year's result is the rich haul of cent percenters. Many a student scored 100 on 100 in various subjects. One of our school toppers, Vrinda scored cent percent marks in Accountancy and Economics while Samridhi got 100 marks in Physical education, Geography and Psychology. Ansh Popli secured 100 marks in Business Studies whereas, Yash Malhotra and Vrinda scored cent percent in Accountancy .

- All India topper in 2020 district topper in 2022 and in 2022.... three eventful years and the triumphant journey of Pratap Public School that started with Pulkit Aghi winning the top academic position at the national level continues.
