ACADEMICS

Once again, Pratap Public School Sector -6 has showcased a remarkable execution of hard work with a laudable 100% result in both the Grade X and XII Central Board Secondary Education Examination in session 2023-2024.

In Grade XII, out of the total students, 29 students scored marks above 90%. A total of 36 students secured 'A' Grades. Sonakshi of class XII NM topped the school with 95.6% marks; she was followed by, Dhriti, Manya and Shubham with 94.8%, while Bhavya and Vartika shared the third spot with 94.4% marks.

At the secondary level, among our glittering stars the most coveted place has been bagged by Ishika of class X. She with 97.6% was the school topper, while Sanyam with 97.2% secured the second position and Kripa with 96.8% stood third.

Pratap's flag fluttered high even in the session 2024-25.In grade 12 Gurleen Kaur with 97.2% became the school topper. She was followed by Avni who with 97.2% stood second, while Tanu Shimar and Kashish shared the third spot with 96.2%. The brilliant performance of the senior secondary level was perfectly replicated by the students at the secondary level. Stuti Tuli stood first with 98% while Ishita with 97.2% & Vanshika with 97% bagged the second and third position respectively. We feel elated to share that 29 of our students of class XII and a record 51 students of class X scored 90% and above marks in board exams.

Another remarkable feature of these academic years is the rich haul of cent percenters. Many a student scored 100 on 100 in various subjects. In session 2023 -24 Aakansha Singh of XII Humanities made us proud by scoring a remarkable 100 in Political Science, Shubham Tripathi got 100 in Music .In class X Arush, Asiya Singh, Ishika, Jagriti, Janat Wallecha, Kripa Vij, Sanyam ,Shaurya Dudeja and Vasundhara secured cent percent marks in AI, whereas Aayan Mehla got 100 marks in Science. Mitul & Sanyam Chaudhry made us proud by scoring a perfect 100 in mathematics while Aayan Mehla & Ishika got 100 marks in Social Science. In session 2024-25, 19 of our students scored cent percent marks in AI. One of our school topper Ishita scored a whopping 100 in IT, whereas Yashasvi scored 100 marks in Science. Nandini made us proud by getting cent percent marks in mathematics, while Ishita Bhatia got 100 in Hindi. In grade 12, 18 of our students secured 100 in painting.
