Pratap’s flag fluttered high in the session 2024-25. In grade XII **Gurleen Kaur** with **97.2%** became the school topper. She was followed by **Avni** who with **97.2%** stood second, while **Tanu Shimar** and **Kashish** shared the third spot with **96.2%**. The brilliant performance of the senior secondary level was perfectly replicated by the students at the secondary level. In class X **Stuti Tuli** stood first with **98%** while **Ishita** with **97.2%** & **Vanshika** with **97%** bagged the second and third position respectively. We feel elated to share that 29 of our students of class XII and a record 51 students of class X scored 90% and above marks in board exams.

Another remarkable feature of the academic session 2024-25 is the rich haul of cent percenters. Many a student scored 100 on 100 in various subjects. An impressive 19 students from our institution achieved cent percent marks in Artificial Intelligence. Our distinguished topper **Ishita** secured a perfect score of **100 in Information Technology**, complemented by **Yashasvi’s** exemplary **100 in science**. **Nandini** earned accolades with **100 in Mathematics**, and **Ishita Bhatia** excelled with **100 in Hindi**. Furthermore, in Grade XII, **18 students** attained **perfect scores in Painting**. Notably, **Gurleen** scored **99 in Accounts, Economics, and Business Studies**, while **Tanu Simar** achieved **99 in Mathematics and Computer Science**. **Anmol** distinguished himself with an outstanding **99 in English**, **Tanisha** excelled with **99 in Economics**, and **Muskan** earned accolades with a stellar **99 in Business Studies**—elevating our institution’s prestige.
